• Length: Papers should be 4–6 pages, including references, tables, and figures.

• Formatting:

- Use Times New Roman, 12-point font, and 1.5 line spacing.
- Include standard margins of 1 inch on all sides.
- Number all pages consecutively.
- Paper Template: IEEE A4 conference template Available at <u>https://www.ieee.org/content/dam/ieee-org/ieee/web/org/conferences/conference-template-a4.docx</u>

• Suggested Headings:

- a. Title Page:
 - i. Title of the paper (bold, centered, and in Title Case).
 - ii. Name(s) of the author(s), affiliation(s), and contact information (email).
- b. Abstract:
- i. A concise summary of 150–250 words outlining the research problem, objectives, methodology, and key findings.
- c. Keywords
 - i. 3-5 keywords
- d. Introduction:
 - i. Context and background of the research.
 - ii. Clear statement of the research problem and objectives.
- e. Literature Review:
 - i. Summary of related work and how your study contributes to the existing knowledge.
- f. Methodology:
 - i. Description of the research approach, techniques, or experiments used.

g. Results and Discussion:

- i. Presentation of findings using tables, graphs, or charts.
- ii. Interpretation of results and their implications.
- h. Conclusion and Future Work:
 - i. Summary of key findings and their significance.
 - ii. Recommendations or potential directions for future research.

i. References:

- i. Use a standard referencing style IEEE numbered format and ensure accuracy.
- Figures and Tables:
 - Place figures and tables near the text where they are referenced.
 - Include appropriate captions (e.g., "Table 1: Overview of Results").

- **Plagiarism**: Papers must be original and free from plagiarism.
- File Format: Submit the paper in PDF or Microsoft Word format.
